PROHIBITORY ORDER
U/S 163 BNSS

WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India have announced the General Elections to Assam Legislative Assembly, 2026 on 15-03-2026 and filling of nomination papers will be conducted at the Integrated DC Office Dhemaji.

AND WHEREAS, para 3.6 of the ECI instructions issued vide No. 464/INST/2009/EPS/87 dated 1st September, 2009 mandates ban on carrying of licensed arms as soon as an election is announced.

AND WHEREAS, I am of considered opinion that immediate preventive measures are necessary to maintain law and order and ensure peaceful conduct of the election process

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Shri Rahul Suresh Javir, IAS, District Magistrate, Dhemaji in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 163 of the BNSS, do hereby order that,


1. There shall be complete ban on carrying of unauthorized/licensed arms w.e.f 15-03-2026 within the jurisdiction of Dhemaji district by any civilian until the election process is over.
2. Assembly of five (05) or more persons is strictly prohibited within the campus of the Integrated District Commissioner's Office, Dhemaji.

These restrictions shall not apply to police personnel, security forces and other government officials on duty.

This order is issued in the interest of maintaining public peace and ensuring smooth conduct of the election process and shall remain in force until further orders unless withdrawn earlier.

Any violation of this order is punishable u/s 223 of BNSS.


