The meeting was presided over by Sri Ankur Bharali ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Dhemaji. At the very outset the chair welcomed all the members present in the meeting and instructed the Head of Department to comply with the Chief Minister's Actionable & Monitorable target and ensure the compilation of the target before deadline. Further, the Chair communicate to all the HoDs about the new direction regarding improvement and increase effectiveness of DDC Meetings as directed by the Principal Secretary to the Govt of Assam, E&M Div, T&D department and shared proforma for submitting financial and physical progress of various schemes that are being implemented by the departments.

The following matters were discussed in the meeting for further necessary action to be taken up by concerned department.
