The meeting was presided over by Sri Ankur Bharali ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Dhemaji. At the very outset the chair welcomed all the members present in the meeting and instructed the Head of Department to comply with the Chief Minister's Actionable & Monitorable target and ensure the compilation of the target before deadline.
